Alton Towers Reward Trip

Detailed below is information about the Alton Towers Reward Trip. I would like to apologise for the delay in information being provided, however the details have just been confirmed with the tour company.

Payment

The final payment of £30 is now due. You can use our online payment system/hand cash or cheques into the school office (all cheques must be made payable to **Falkirk Council**). The total cost of the trip is £55 and if you are unsure about how much you have paid then please get in touch. Thank you to those who have already made the full payment.

Pupil Information Forms

Every pupil should have completed a *Pupil Information Form*. If there are any updates required to medical and/or dietary information then please get in touch.

Buses

Bus lists are posted on Google Classroom. Every pupil going on the trip has been invited to join the page. Year groups are together and staff are divided evenly between four coaches.

Pupils may bring snacks for the bus as long as they use the bins provided. They may also bring money to purchase food in the service stations which we will be stopping at to use the toilet facilities. Pupils may also bring a pillow/blanket if they wish to sleep on the bus.

Money

Pupils will need to purchase lunch in the park as food/packed lunches cannot be taken in. I have spoken with colleagues who went on the S2 Residential visit to Alton Towers and they have said £10 should be more than enough to purchase lunch in the park. Pupils may bring additional monies for souvenirs if they wish.

Itinerary

We will be departing school at **2am on Thursday 28 June**. Pupils should arrive by **1.45am** and make their way to their bus. The buses will be parked at the top of the AstroTurf and so I would appreciate if you did not park in these bus bays.

As we have a significant number of pupils going on the trip I would ask if we could use Carronrange Avenue as a one-way road. A suggested route is indicated below which will hopefully ease the congestion and ensure everyone arrives at the bus on time. There are many other bus bays around Carronrange Avenue which I would ask you to use to drop pupils off.
